Understanding of the World.

History

- Learn about the houses that were lived in at the time
- Comparing Anglo Saxon/Viking clothes with our clothes
- Sorting Anglo Saxon and modern artefacts
- Understand the Anglo Saxon timeline

Geography

- Using maps and globes to find Lindisfarne
- Mapping an Anglo Saxon Village

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Begin to work through the All about me/Decision making/Family and Friendships section of Sexual Health Booklet
- Circle Time sessions to support making choices, for the present and in their future

Mathematics

- Problem solving using tide timetables
- Data from field study, how many cars in the car park, people on the beach, then use ways of displaying this in graph form
- Discover 2D and 3D shapes that are found in the environment when we visit the island
- Use nets of shapes to create houses, cuboids, cubes etc
- Learn the properties of shapes

Expressive Art and Design.

- Design a stamp that commemorates a part of the Islands history
- Design a poster that encourages people to protect the environment of the Island
- Design and make a Viking long boat
- Create an Anglo Saxon Village
- Create a model of the Priory

Physical Development.

- Developing stamina through increasing walking distances when out on visits
- Developing ball skills through specific ball skills lessons, including cricket and netball
- Developing the use of batting skills through cricket sessions

RE (Festivals/Celebrations)

- Discover the history of the Lindisfarne Gospels
- Learn about the history of St Cuthbert, his story and connection to Lindisfarne
- Learn about Anglo Saxon beliefs and their Gods
- Learn About the Anglo Saxons conversion to Christianity
