Key fact: Julius Caesar was from Italy.

Learn about Italy.

Geography – where is Italy? Find it on the map. How do we get there? Making a map of Italy for the display (it's shaped like a boot!)

Art and design – making the flag of Italy. (shape, measure, colour)

Languages – what language do they speak? Learning some basic Italian words.

Cooking/sensory – tasting and smelling Italian ingredients and cooking Italian dishes.

MAPP Learning

Incorporating individual MAPP targets into all our learning. These targets focus mainly on -

- Communication
- Functional skills, including number work and reading
- Functional living skills
- Physical movement through P.E and O.T programmes.
- PHSE – e.g., listening, taking turns, respect, friendship, kindness, making choices.

Key facts: Julius Caesar was a commander of an army. He lived over 2000 years ago. He became the leader of Rome.

Learn about being a leader.

History and role play – what did he wear? Dressing up as Julius Caesar. Playing commanders and soldiers. Caesar captured by pirates. Caesar riding over the Rubicon river to Rome to become the leader of the city.

Famous saying – “*I came, I saw, I conquered*” – incorporate into role play and writing as a heading for display. Makaton signing. Meanings of word ‘conquered’.

Art and design – what did he look like? Recreating Julius in art/sculpture. Making replica coins. Making wreaths.

PHSE/Citizenship – making decisions and choices.
