Sycamore Class Planning - Spring 2021

Theme - Seasonal Changes - Weather and Plant Growth

Focus on a season per week during January and February - week of the 11th - Winter; 18th - Spring; 25th - Summer; 1st - Autumn

Week of 11th - Introduce the changes throughout the year then focus on winter

Ideas connected to video

- Art The children could make a set of drawings and paintings to show the changing of the seasons. Individual pictures in their topic books.
- They could freeze-frame images they see in the clip, to use as sources of inspiration.
- Maths Collecting and grouping activity such as fruits and seeds (autumn), gloves (winter), eggs (spring) and sun glasses (summer).
- Maths Learn the order of the months of the year and relate calendar months to the appropriate season.

Learning associated with videos and related activities – attention skills (watching and listening); literacy (writing); communication (answering questions).

Field to Fork Suggestions (full info attached) - Winter

- Make a recycled bird feeder (see also Cbeebies Mr Bloom – using pine cones)
- Natural stained glass windows for when temperatures drop below zero

Cookery for each season, using seasonal produce and linking to festivals (e.g., Winter warmer recipes e.g., soups, stews, hot chocolate.)

Planting seeds and watching them grow.

Creating an art display based on a seed germinating and growing. Learning that plants need water and sunlight.

Maths and Science - Measurement

- Rainfall make a rain gauge
- **Temperature** Thermometer readings
- Wind strength making windmills
