Sycamore Class April 2021

Geography Theme - The Countries of the United Kingdom

General Aim - To name, locate and identify characteristics of the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas

In Sycamore class, we plan activities to suit the needs of our learners, and incorporate individual MAPP target to make the learning relevant to each pupil. The priorities for our learners are communication skills, motor skills, and learning to work with others. The initial outline for activities is below, and further activities will be added throughout the term, and included in daily planning.

Learning for some -

- 1. To learn that the United Kingdom is made up of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland
- 2. To learn that each country has a capital city London, Edinburgh, Cardiff and Belfast
- 3. To learn one (or more) distinctive landmarks of each capital city

Focus on one city per week, roughly.

Art, D&T incorporating motor skills and maths.

- Creating models/dens of landmarks (to be used in P.E)
- Making signposts and flags for use in P.E and role play
- Creating a picture map of the UK for display
- Making a London Bus
- Motor skills using tools (scissors, paint tools, ruler)

Mathematics

- Vocabulary of size comparing heights of landmarks – bigger, biggest, smaller, smallest.
- Knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes in relation to building models of the landmarks.
- Counting practice and measuring length/height/distance - counting our strides and experience of using rulers, metre sticks, trundle wheels
- Coding and directions outside play following instructions to move between cities.

Communication, interaction and literacy

- Individual writing tasks writing city and county labels to attach to maps
- Using Twinkl resources to support learning about each capital city - e.g., fact matching cards, word searches, bingo, powerpoints, photos
- Descriptive language verbal communication and use of PECS to describe landmarks
- Reading library books, powerpoints, fact sheets.
- Working with others learning to share space, and take turns during activities
- Communicating choices using voice or symbols to make choices between and within activities
- Attention skills watching and listening to programmes and answering questions
- Makaton signs e.g., Mr Tumble and Singing Hands online
