Year 12 16/17 years old—Transition plan is reviewed as part of the annual review process. EHCP in place, ASDAN courses are taken. Pupils can continue to attend The Grove School. Discussions about Apprenticeships, Careers Guidance, Parent/pupil can choose to visit colleges/alternative provisions.

Work experience continues. For the following year school staff need to show that the pupil can make academic progress towards, further education or employment

If appropriate pupil may leave to attend a different education provision. Change of placement request made, SEND panel to agree funding EHCP will stay in place

Year 11 15/16 years old—Transition plan is reviewed as part of the annual review process. EHCP in place, ASDAN courses are taken. Pupils can continue to attend The Grove School, Discussions about Apprenticeships, Careers Guidance

Work experience either to begin in school or other work places.

Year 10 14/15 years old—Transition plan is reviewed as part of the annual review process. EHCP in place, ASDAN courses are taken, Discussions about Apprenticeships, Careers Guidance.

Begin to look for and discuss work experience

Year 9 13/14 years old—transition plan is written with pupils + parents
