Using Materials in the Garden and Sensory Exploration

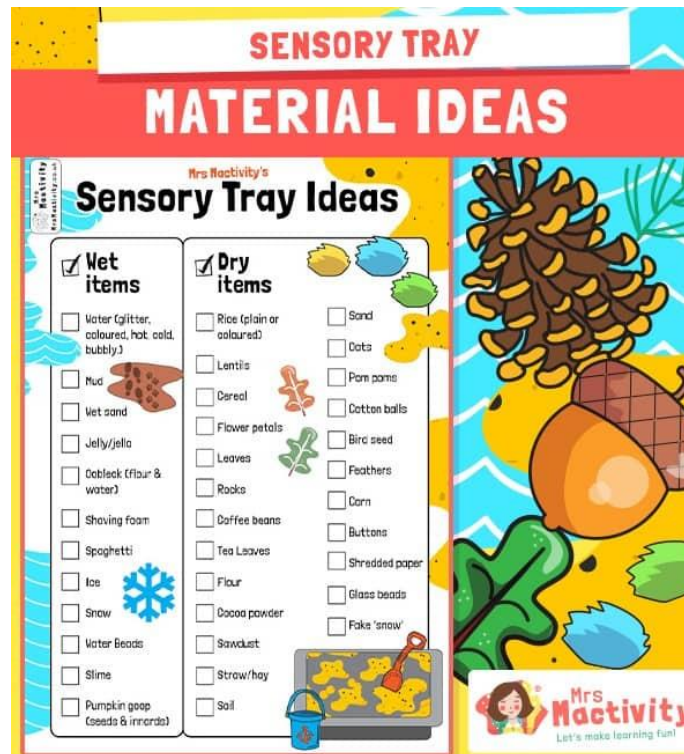
We will link our learning to outdoor learning by thinking about the needs of wildlife and plants -

- We will collect materials to re-use in the garden and yard.
- We will learn to identify and sort plastic, tin and wood
- We will use a range of tools to create feeders, plant pot and wildlife homes
- We will use our motor skills to create items for the garden
- We will talk about mathematical concepts, including two and three dimensional shape; capacity/volume; empty/full; smaller/bigger; straight/curved.

- Shiny, hard, smooth, reflective, ice
- Rough, prickly, sandy, gravel
- Wet, slimy, gooey, jelly, muddy, dough
- Dry, sand, soil, shredded paper, leaves
- Soft, feathers, flowers

We will link to food exploration.

We will use a variety of containers and implements.

We will use our motor skills to cut, mix, pour, use tongs, etc.
